## Alzchem Group AG: Significant Change in Shareholder Structure

**Trostberg, August 5, 2025** – Löw SE has reduced its stake in Alzchem Group AG to 9.9 percent (compared to the previously notified 19.61 percent). In parallel, STALUNA TRADE a.s., which belongs to Czechoslovak Group a.s. (CSG), acquired a 9.2 percent stake in the company.

CSG is an internationally active industrial holding company headquartered in the Czech Republic and doing business particularly in the fields of defense, mobility, chemicals, high-tech and aerospace.

Alzchem is pleased about the expansion of its investor base and welcomes CSG as a new, significant shareholder. The company's strategy and operational focus remain unaffected by the change in ownership structure. The company will continue its dialogue with all shareholders as usual.
